

## Tuition Scholarships

The following scholarships are available for SMCS families:

### General Scholarship

Each year a limited amount of tuition scholarship money is provided for families to assist with tuition. Returning families must submit scholarship application AND requested tax forms to FAST Aid. FAST Aid is a third party organization that reviews the applications and forms to determine eligibility. After the review FAST Aid provides SMCS with a need based recommendations for qualified families. SMCS will notify returning families of their Scholarship Funds status. New families can apply to FAST Aid for any remaining funds once open enrollment begins and their application has been received.

### Sheets Memorial Baptist Church Member Scholarship

This is a 5% scholarship available to active members of Sheets Memorial Baptist Church and applies to the oldest child enrolled.

### Pastor Ministry Scholarship

This is a 20% scholarship available to a parent/guardian that is a current active pastor. The parent must complete an application each year to confirm current pastoral status. The scholarship applies only to the oldest child enrolled.

### NC Opportunity Scholarships

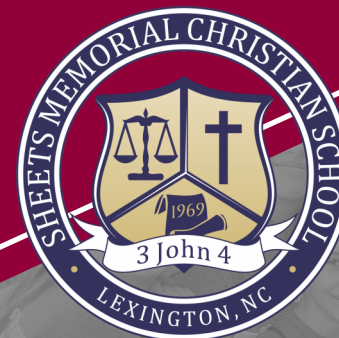

# Financial Definitions

## Application Fee

A non-refundable fee paid by first time students in K5-12th when submitting the application to attend.

## Re-Enrollment Fee

Annual non-refundable fee paid each spring by returning students in K5-12th to ensure placement for the following year.

## Registration Fee

Annual non-refundable fee paid by all students. Must accompany new application and re-enrollment forms.

## Graduation /K5 Graduation Fee

Fee paid by seniors & K5 students to cover some of the costs of graduation such as cap and gown, diploma, honor cords, and the reception.

## HS Elective Classes

Fees paid by students in selected high school elective classes to cover the costs of materials or activities. Examples of these classes are Woodshop, Outdoor Adventure, Art, and others.

## MS/HS Class Trips

Both the 8th grade and 12th grade take an annual trip. The 8th grade takes a three day trip to an historical site like Washington DC or Williamsburg. The 12th grade participates in a week long missions focused trip.

## MS/HS Retreats

Each September the entire MS and HS student body goes on a retreat. The MS retreat is one day retreat the Tuesday after Labor Day. The HS retreat is a 2-3 day retreat the week after Labor Day.

## Eagle Care Before/After School Care

A program for K5 to grade 8 students. Open 7 AM to 6 PM

## Eagle Care Summer Camp

A school-end to school-start summer camp program for students in K5 through 6th grade. The program includes weekly learning themes, arts and crafts, and field trips.

## SOAR Learning

A unique program for students with diagnosed learning concerns. A variety of programs are available for students in K5 through grade 12. The SOAR programs does require an additional fee beyond tuition. There are limited available spaces for each grade.

## Sheets Memorial Preschool & Daycare

A school year Preschool Kindergarten readiness program for children ages 2 through 4. Costs include snacks and lunch on regular school days. Along with the Preschool programs they offer summer camp for 2 to 4 year olds. The year round daycare program provides care for children 6 weeks old to 2. Summer camp is also provided for the preschool children. Please contact the Preschool for detailed information.
