

## Annual Fees Definition

Annual Fees are fees that are required to be paid in full at the time of billing. These fees cannot be added to the monthly draft.

### **New Student Application Fee**

A non-refundable fee paid by first time students in K2-12th when submitting the application to attend.

### **Returning Student Re-Enrollment Fee**

Annual non-refundable fee paid each spring by returning students in K2-12th to inform the school of your intent to return. Must accompany re-enrollment forms.

### **Registration Fee**

Annual non-refundable fee that secures your child's position.

### **Curriculum & Resource Fee**

Annual non-refundable fee that covers textbooks, instructional materials, student classroom supplies, and fine arts supplies (including art and music), yearbook and more. There is a technology portion to help maintain and upgrade crucial classroom technology.

For the Middle School and High School the resource fee includes one set of P.E. uniforms, class dues, and the Spiritual Emphasis events. Fees include the rental costs of a Chromebook laptop that are issued to each 9th-12th grade student for usage in the classroom.

## Incidental Fee Definitions

### **HS Elective Classes**

Fees paid by students in selected high school elective classes to cover the costs of materials or activities. Examples of these classes are Woodshop, Outdoor Adventure, Art, and others.

### **Graduation /K5 Graduation Fee**

Fee paid by high school seniors & K5 students to cover some of the costs of graduation such as cap and gown, diploma, honor cords, and the reception.

### **Sports Fee**

Paid by each athlete once added to the roster of a team.

### **Early Withdrawal Fee**

Students are considered enrolled for the entire school year; therefore, budgets and teacher contracts are set accordingly. The early withdrawal of a student creates an opening which SMCS may not be able to fill with a viable candidate.

## Available Scholarships

The following scholarships are available for SMCS families:

### **General Scholarship**

SMCS knows that a Biblical education is a sacrifice for families. To help families, this General Scholarship has been developed to ease the burden. Returning families have from February 1 to March 1 each year to apply and receive first-come priority. New families can apply once open enrollment begins on a first-come availability basis. Families apply for the scholarship through a third party group called FAST Aid. Each family must complete the scholarship application, submit tax information and pay the processing fee to FAST Aid. FAST will provide a need-based scholarship recommendation to SMCS. SMCS will then apply the funds as available. A link to FAST Aid is on the admissions page of our website.

### **SMBC Membership Scholarship**

This is a 5% scholarship available to active members of Sheets Memorial Baptist Church and applies to the oldest child enrolled.

### **Pastor Ministry Scholarship**

This is a 20% scholarship available to a parent that is a current active pastor. The parent must complete an application each year to confirm current pastoral status. The scholarship applies only to the oldest child enrolled.

### **NC Opportunity Scholarships**

New families and students entering K5 or first grade may be eligible for the NC Opportunity Scholarship. Go to

## Kinder Kampus Monthly Bank Draft Charges & Fees

### August to May Kinder Kampus Tuition

This is the regular annual cost of Kindergarten classes for the student from August to May. It can be paid by 10 monthly drafts, or semi annually in August and January, or paid in full by August 15 to receive a 4% discount. The monthly draft includes daily lunch, before school care (7:00am to 8:00am), after school care (3:00pm to 6:00pm), and care on closed days when available.

### June and July Camp

A summer camp is available for students in the kindergarten program during the months of June and July. Parents will be asked to register for the weeks they will need care. The summer camp program costs \$150.00 per registered week. Lunch is not provided during the summer months.

## Day School: Grades 1-12 Monthly Bank Draft Charges

### Day School Tuition: Grades 1-12

This is the regular annual cost of classes for the student. It can be paid by 11 monthly drafts, or semi annually in August and January, or paid in full by August 15 to receive a 4% discount.

### S.O.A.R. Learning program

A unique program for students with diagnosed learning concerns. Students are placed into a learning tier based on the student's need. The SOAR program requires an additional cost beyond tuition. There are limited spaces available for each grade.

### Lunch Program

SMCS offers annual prepaid lunch services. Parents can select to participate in the lunch program, have their student bring lunch from home or send cash with the student to buy lunch on any given day. The annual lunch program is the most cost effective if a child buys lunch 10+ days a month.

### Eagle Care: Before/After School Care

An annual program for 1st grade to 8th grade students. Open 7 AM to 6 PM. Parents can choose to participate in morning care only, afternoon care only or both. This is a prepaid service. Students enrolled in the program can also attend Eagle Care during half days and teacher workday days. Any accrued late fees will be added to the next month's draft.
